YEAR 2019-2020**




- During the introductory session, Dr. L. Chinnappa, Chair of the Anti-Ragging Committee, detailed the roles and responsibilities of each committee member in managing ragging complaints within the institution. The session clarified the committee's purpose, highlighting the critical need to maintain a safe and welcoming environment for students.
- To support these efforts, anti-ragging signage and posters were installed in prominent campus locations, including the cafeteria, classroom corridors, restrooms, and canteens. Additionally, surprise inspections were conducted by vigilance officers in various campus areas such as hostels and buses. These inspections revealed no instances of ragging.
- The committee also verified that all students and their parents have completed the necessary anti-ragging affidavits. On August 14, 2019, an awareness program was held to further educate the campus community about anti-ragging policies. Details of any grievances raised during this academic year are outlined below:
